LOGLINE

Set at the end of a humid East Coast summer, a close-knit group of family and friends gather to memorialize one of their own.

SYNOPSIS

Take Me With You is set in the waning days of an East Coast summer...

The Lee Brothers - Avett, Aaron, and Andrew - host a most unusual backyard pool party with their father and three close friends. This group of bathing suit clad young adults reminisce about their relationships and experiences with the brothers' late mother - yet it appears something is being left unsaid.

The brothers connect with one another, as well as their respective partners, exlovers, and current infatuations, causing old wounds to reopen and a sense of uncertainty to permeate the air. While this seemingly lazy afternoon carries on, it becomes clear this gathering has a deeper, more pressing purpose - to memorialize the boys' mother in a most untraditional, strangely funny, and surprisingly disgusting way.

GARY MEMI is a New York City based award-winning director and short film producer. With over 20 years of experience, he often collaborates with Off-Broadway theater company The Barrow Group on their film projects and festivals, and has worked in TV, film and theater in and around New York since 2000. Gary is the Senior Director of Productions Operations for New York's iconic MSG Entertainment. He studied writing, fine arts, and anthropology at Florida International University. Gary lives in Long Island, NY, with his wife and son, and runs MemiFam Films.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

Take Me With You draws attention to the tender, often unnoticed moments in people's lives. Set against a suburban backdrop, it is a snapshot of how seven individuals cope with tragedy, family, and interpersonal relationships in subtle and unique ways. We uncover love in its many forms - from parent to child, sibling to sibling, lover to lover. My vision for this film, and in all projects, is to find the poetry in the picture, to let the dialogue speak for itself. I am drawn to layered sounds and music - the rhythms that bring action to life, explore moods, and push stories forward.

As we emerge from the COVID-19 pandemic, stories such as this one are even more vital. So many have felt the pang of loss, anxiety surrounding change, and uncertainty as an unknown future unfolds. This film is a point of connection and catharsis for all who seek a little humor in times of hardship.



EXECUTIVE PRODUCER


ORIGINAL MUSIC

They successfully crowd-funded and sold-out of the vinyl pressings of all three of their full-length records. Steven is managed by **Asbury Films** in NYC.


